Scheme (SSSTS) - Refresher**

Overview:

This one-day course is for site supervisors or those with supervisory responsibilities who currently hold an existing 2-day SSSTS within the scope of renewal requirements and would benefit from the SSSTS Refresher course.

Aim:

The SSSTS Refresher course aims to ensure that all those given supervisory responsibilities understand:

- Why they are carrying out their identified duties
- What is expected of them and to ensure that they contribute to the safety of the workplace.

Content:

On successful completion of the SSSTS Refresher course, delegates will:

- Understand the problems of the industry
- Have an understanding of how health and safety law is structured and how it applies to supervisors
- Identify how their supervisory role fits in with the management structure in controlling the site safely
- Carry out risk assessments and understand the need for method statements
- Carry out effective site inductions, toolbox talks and method statement briefings
- Be able to monitor site activities effectively
- Understand the importance of timely intervention when bad practice is identified.

At the end of the SSSTS Refresher course delegates will be asked to complete a multiple-choice assessment.

Note:

Delegates **MUST** bring some form of photographic ID along on the day of the course. Where identification is not provided, attendance will be refused.
